OPTIONAL TRANSPORTATION INSURANCE

Customers have the option of purchasing transportation insurance. If a student no longer requires transportation for any reason after the contract is signed, 60% of the prorated unused portion of the transportation fee will be refunded.

BUS STOP AND PASSENGER INFORMATION

When logistically feasible, particularly in areas close to The School and areas that have a high concentration of bus riders, door-to-door service is more likely to be offered. In some cases, such as outlying areas that are considerably farther from school or from a proposed route, regional locations will be established as an alternative to door-to-door service. Typically, regional bus stops will be a 3-10 minute drive from a bus rider's home. If a regional location is the only option available for a pick-up and/or drop-off location, and the location is not acceptable to the parent/guardian, the parent/guardian may cancel the contract, in writing, on or before Friday, August 12, 2016. Every effort will be made to keep your child's bus ride as short as possible. Students picked up in the morning farthest from school should expect about a 6:35-7:00 a.m. pick-up time. Buses will arrive at school at approximately 8:00-8:10 a.m. Afternoon buses will depart at 4:25 p.m. on regular school days and at 12:30 p.m. on half days. Riders added to a route after busing commences will be billed on a prorated basis of the remaining school days from the date of ridership. The School reserves the right to make changes to pick-up/drop-off times to accommodate necessary route changes at any time during the school year. PLEASE NOTE: Road conditions due to weather, construction, and traffic congestion can alter route times that are beyond the control of the bus company and The International School of Minnesota and cannot be used as grounds to cancel this contract. We appreciate your patience.

MAXIMUM / MINIMUM RIDERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

In the event that the maximum capacity of a bus route is reached, seats will be filled according to the order that signed contracts were received. If a route has not met the minimum requirement two weeks before the first day of school, ISM reserves the right not to offer the route, or any other transportation alternative. ISM reserves the right to enforce a minimum ridership per route.

I understand that this is a binding contract and that by signing below I agree to all terms and conditions outlined. I agree to make full payment for each student I have listed above. I understand the total payment due will be calculated based on the rates published above. I understand that withdrawal of a student from the transportation program for any reason does not relieve me of any portion of the total amount due, unless I have chosen to purchase transportation insurance. I understand the students listed above must abide by the Bus Rules set forth by ISM and that any behavior that violates the Bus Rules will result in the appropriate disciplinary action. I also understand no refund is granted for any passenger permanently expelled from the bus for behavior reasons. I agree that The International School of Minnesota shall have no liability whether in contract or tort or otherwise arising out of my child's use of bus transportation, and I agree to indemnify, protect, and hold harmless The School from any claim or liability whatsoever, including, but not limited to, personal injury arising out of or in any way related to my child's use of bus transportation.
