WHAT ARE WE LEARNING?

Dear Parents in PREK A

This week in our class, we had a wonderful and productive learning experience! In phonics, we learned about the letter L. The children traced the letter L in their phonics books, reviewed the letters I and F, and practiced shaping them using playdough, which was a lot of fun and helped reinforce their fine motor skills.

In science, we continued our exploration of plants. Last week, we learned about how plants grow, and this week, we focused on planting seeds. The children had the opportunity to plant their own seeds, learn how to water them, and understand the process of growing plants.

We also worked on our number recognition skills. The children practiced recognizing numbers based on their colors and traced the number three in their books, which helped build their confidence with numbers.

Finally, we dedicated some time to arts and crafts. The children used Mod Podge to draw and decorate a leaf, then glued colorful tissue paper onto it to create a beautiful leaf collage. It was wonderful to see their creativity and enthusiasm!

We are so proud of all their efforts and progress this week.
