Social Studies

<u>3rd Grade:</u> We identified environmental issues and concerns. We discussed the pros and cons of different energy sources.

<u>4th Grade:</u> We described how immigration changed the Northeast and the United States. We explained the goals of important reform movements that had their roots in the Northeast. We detailed the problems large cities faced and how cities solved those problems.
