# SUMMER ADVENTURE CAMP

## *The Best of Minnesota Summer in One Camp*

Summer Adventure Camp offers a ton of fun activities to spark curiosity and boost learning. With a great mix of indoor and outdoor programs, kids can find an activity they love or discover a new interest.

### **THE EXPLORERS: PRESCHOOL – ENTERING KINDERGARTEN**

Participants must have turned 3 years old by January 1, 2018, and be fully toilet-trained. Explorers can participate in a half-day (morning) or full-day program.

All explorers engage in:

- Daily language classes and cultural exploration to learn language basics and discover music, art, and world traditions during 4 weeks of French and 4 weeks of Spanish
- Daily swimming lessons in our indoor lap-sized learning pool
- Classroom arts & crafts that bring out the fun in young creative minds
- Nature hikes on our beautiful campus trails
- Outside play time including exploration in the peace garden, fun on our playgrounds, and lively camp games
- Friday Beach Day at the neighboring Bryant Lake Beach (morning activity)
- Explorers also enjoy afternoon rest and playtime



Campers are welcome from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. for fun activities.

### **THE PIONEERS: ENTERING GRADES 1-6**

Pioneers can participate in half-day morning, afternoon, or full-day programs. Pioneers also have a chance to add optional Adventure Afternoon activities (see Adventure Afternoons).

- Daily language class and cultural exploration to practice languages and discover music, art, and traditions from around the world during 4 weeks of French and 4 weeks of Spanish
- Daily swimming lessons in our indoor lap-sized learning pool
- Bi-weekly visits from KIDCREATE Studio in our art room
- Nature hikes to explore the many nature trails on campus and Bryant Lake Park
- Canoe lessons in our pool with the opportunity to canoe and fish on Bryant Lake
- Outside play time includes nature exploration in the peace garden and on our trails, fun on the playgrounds and fields, and exciting outdoor games like Capture the Flag
- Friday Beach Day at the neighboring Bryant Lake Beach (full day)

### **COUNSELORS IN TRAINING (CIT): ENTERING GRADES 7-9**

The Counselor in Training (CIT) program gives our campers a feel for what it takes to be a counselor, while still having the opportunity to participate in all that Summer Adventure Camp has to offer, including the option to add Adventure Afternoon activities. These campers take a leadership role in the group, assisting camp counselors and teachers with activities and programs.

As a CIT, they will have the opportunity to develop the skills and confidence that will help them to become effective leaders and positive role models. Successful participants will come away from this program with valuable experiences that will serve them well at home, in school, and in their community, as well as being awarded a certificate at the end of summer.





## ADVENTURE AFTERNOONS

### *Extra Options for Grades 2-9*

#### **JUNE 18-22: GARDENING CAMP**

Campers will participate in the design and growth of ISM's Peace Garden. They will learn the basics of planting and maintaining trees and decorative plants, and help maintain and harvest new vegetable beds. Special attention will be paid to how these gardens interact with the wider natural world that surrounds them. Campers will take part in creating a garden that will be used and enjoyed during the school year and summers beyond!

**Open to students in grades 2-9**

#### **JUNE 25-29: KEVIN LYNCH BASKETBALL CAMP**

Former NBA and Gopher basketball player's famous camp program for boys and girls teaches skills through drills and games. The goal? Learn, improve, and have lots of fun!

**Open to students in grades 3-9**

This program is a full-day activity from 9 a.m.- 3 p.m.

#### **JULY 2-6: NO CAMP DURING 4<sup>TH</sup> OF JULY WEEK**

#### **JULY 9-13: EXPLORE MN BIOLOGY**

The great outdoors beckons and our naturalist instructor leads the exploration of our 55-acres of woods and other habitats. In this science course, campers will learn about plants, animals, and even fungi. They will collect samples and learn survival skills for exploring the woods and the pond to find out what lives there. Discover the wonders of nature right here on the ISM campus!

**Open to students in grades 2-9**

#### **JULY 16-20: ISM CODING CAMP**

Get acquainted with computer programming in a fun, relaxed environment at ISM's coding camp this summer. Campers will learn the basics of creating digital art, designing games, and designing apps. They will also learn to use algorithms to solve problems and create programs to accomplish



specific tasks. Take home new technology skills as well as programs we create during the camp.

#### **JULY 23-27: MUSIC AND THEATER WORKSHOP 1**

#### **JULY 30 - AUGUST 3: SCIENCE EXPLORERS - ELECTRICAL ENGINEERING**

Ready for some hair-raising, hands-on, fun? Then join Electrical Engineering and explore and learn to build electrical circuits with batteries, wires, motors, buzzers, switches all while learning about electricity and the flow of electrons. You will also investigate which liquid solutions will conduct electricity, plus build battery-powered gadgets including an electromagnet and a flashlight to take home.

#### **AUGUST 6-10: SCIENCE EXPLORERS - SIMPLE MACHINES**

Do you like building with Lego® bricks and KEX®? Then put your building skills to the test as an elementary engineer by designing and constructing with simple machines. Construct a hand-drill, pulley system, crane, and more as you use your math and science knowledge. Then build a sail car, simple catapult, and a marble coaster to take home as you investigate and solve engineering challenges in this engaging, hands-on class.
